The School of Rehabilitation of the Faculty of Medicine of the Université de Montréal (UdeM) is seeking an exceptional researcher in the field of occupational therapy and mental health for a tenure track position as assistant or associate professor.

Responsibilities

- Teaching at the undergraduate, Master's and Doctorate levels.
- Supervision of graduate students.
- Carrying out an active research program in the domain of expertise.
- Participation in the department's academic committees and services.
- Contribution to scientific and professional activities.

Requirements

The successful candidate must have completed a degree in occupational therapy and a PhD in rehabilitation sciences or in a related field. The candidate must be eligible to the Ordre des ergothérapeutes du Québec. The candidates' expertise must be in mental health or have applications related to this area of practice in occupational therapy. The candidate should have completed postdoctoral training and demonstrated active engagement in research activities. Early-career researchers who are in the process of establishing their own research program and who have a very competitive record will also be considered. Teaching and clinical experience will be favorably taken into consideration.

The language of instruction is French; a non-francophone should be able to teach in French at the latest three years after being appointed to the position.
